

The Regional Examination Boards

The Regional Examination Boards are institutions formed by the Minister of National Education in order to organize and administer external examinations in the region belonging to a particular Regional Examination Board.

The responsibilities of the Regional Examination Boards are as follows:

- administering the tests and examinations,
- preparing, in cooperation with the Central Examination Board, the suggestions for questions, tasks, materials and exam sets for conducting tests and examinations,
- preparing, in cooperation with the Central Examination Board, suggestions for questions, tasks, materials and exam sets to be published in the Syllabus for each subject,
- analysing the results of the tests and examinations and formulating the conclusions,
- preparing and submitting reports on conducted tests and examinations to directors of schools, schools' leading bodies, school inspectors and the Central Examination Board,
- training examiners and candidates for examiners,
- cooperation with other Regional Examination Boards and the Central Examination Board,
- keeping a registry of examiners,
- cooperation with school inspectors appropriate for the region belonging to a particular Regional Examination Board with regard to the conducting of tests and examinations and teachers' improvement in diagnosis, assessing, examining and studying the educational achievements of students.
